Ever wonder who is responsible for the tree in between you and your neighbors' home? Trick question...

It's both of you! Each paired home shares custody of the tree that falls between their front entryways.

So, what does that mean?
It means that you both are responsible for maintaining its shape and health. Ensure your tree is well pruned and watered (it is part of your sprinkler system!)

Keeping your tree well pruned will promote healthy growth and keep it from interfering with the structure of your home/walkways. If the tree should die or need to be removed, both homeowners will be required to replace it with a tree comparable to the initial tree.*

Use this as an opportunity to test out your green thumb and get to know your neighbor better!

Determine how/when the upkeep of the tree will take place and how the responsibility will be shared!

*Replacements must go through Design Review Committee
